Since only one liter of water weighs over two pounds, those costs add up - but the real benefit of DriPADs is their ability to improve turn-around efficiency, reduce clean-up time and manage the mess and associated hazards of biofluids in the care environment."

"DriPADs are applied at the source of the fluids and contain the biohazard mess immediately. This means our hospital customers can save time and money each time their staff uses a DriPAD - time that would have been spent cleaning floors or equipment - not to mention the added worker safety. When compared to other disposables available to institutions and consumers, there just is no product available that absorbs and disinfects like a DriPAD does," said Jarvis
