Blogs.info currently has 60 different categories of blogs. Users can suggest additional categories if they think their blog does not fit into an existing category. There is no fee for listing a blog in the directory and listings are usually added within 48 hours. Blogs.info is also a great resource for blog readers looking to discover new blogs.
