"Whether they are searching and comparing cameras for a gift, or planning a vacation to some exotic place, the Internet has become a prime source of data. And when that research involves multiple parties, say a family reunion where all the different family members have to arrange travel to the same local, then sharing the collective knowledge become the hurdle." ReCon, with its support for multiple Topics within a BOK, facilitates not only the travel portion of the trip, but can be used to organize activities, track individuals likes and desires, and chronicle the trip as well.
