There are innumerable lessons to be garnered from the experiences encountered, especially from the unorthodox techniques that were employed to accommodate Shaun's special needs.

Mixed in with all this are humorous situations to add levity and fascinating snippets to keep the reader wildly entertained.

In spite of Shaun's limitations, Mr. Fedele considers his son to be a true gift from God. Hence, the title of the book, "God's Gift." In fact, the meaning of the name, Shaun, translates to "God's gracious gift."

People, who've read sample chapters, found them fascinating and wished they could have had more. Because of it, Mr. Fedele feels that these memoirs will have a wide appeal and should be an inspiration to all.
