Sahagian recently signed a publishing deal with the legendary Jay Warner of National League Music. Warner is an 8 time Grammy award winning publisher known for publishing songs in Oscar winning movies and has been influential to the success of music heavyweights like Bruce Springsteen, Rick James, Mariah Carey, The Rascals, Jimmy Webb, Gladys Knight and more.

The event is an opportunity for filmmakers, students or anyone interested in being involved with cinema to hear what is happening with filmmaking in Rhode Island. It is open to the public and will be held at Borders Books and Music, Garden City, 190 Hillside Rd., Cranston Rhode Island on Friday, March 9th at 7:00 pm.
