With capabilities of unlimited domains and a web based administration console, end users have found the system very intuitive. "The system takes less than 30 minutes to get up and running. It simply attaches into your network and handles post - processed emails. This way your security infrastructure will have cleaned up all the data before it gets to the archive appliance" said Alani Kuye, Managing Partner of the Connecticut based vendor. "With Citrix acquiring XenSource, we will see a surge in broader implementation of open source systems.

More importantly, we have to be ready to address integration needs and keep a very transparent approach. Delivering our system source code in escrow to end clients further reinforces the trust and more importantly it helps deliver strategic support, integrative systems and more importantly and avenue to further understand the clients infrastructure." continued Alani.

Furthermore, When asked how this may affect intellectual property and bottom line, "Source code in escrow only serves and a blanket of protection for all parties involved. It's mainly the basic code that explains the architecture. Which is fully protected under the law and which we provide support for. We have covered all basis in that area". When asked about the price tag, "This depends on alot of variables such as capacity in gigabytes, terabytes or petabytes as the case may be, among other requirements. It may run anywhere from eight thousand to two million dollars. Hence a good requirements gathering approach." added Alani.
