The song has been released by the 2Simple Trust who are helping several children suffering from neuroblastoma, the condition affecting Jack. Neuroblastoma is a solid tumour cancer, which spreads rapidly. There is currently no Government funding for treatment and the 2Simple Trust is helping Jack, his parents, both Detective Sergeants at the Metropolitan Police, as well as his brother Connor, 10, and sister Rhian, 7, in their battle with this disease.
