The most difficult part to climb was on the final stretch through the Kumba Glacier but it was all worth it. When I reached Base Camp the views were breathtaking and it was such a rewarding moment – one of the best experiences in my life. I would like to thank everyone for their support and encouragements in helping me achieve my fundraising target, especially Meteor meet and greet parking who donated £1,500 towards the trek. This donation will make such a vital difference to the people and families who have been affected by stroke."
